THIS MONTH'S MEDITATION SCRIPTURE: The Lord God has given Me the tongue of disciples (those instructed), that I may know how to sustain the weary one with a word. He awakens Me morning by morning, He awakens my ear to listen (hearing, with the implication to obey) as a disciple. The Lord God has opened My ear; and I was not disobedient, nor did I turn back.

Call It An Epiphany—Maybe

I had an epiphany the other day, I think. You know how, in your journey with the Lord, there are some things you instinctively know, other things you learn by being taught, and still other things you just kind of picked up along the way, but you just may not recognize them for what they actually are until someone either intentionally or unintentionally points it out to you? (I hope I haven't lost you already.) I had one of those times this past week.

Throughout a series of conversations I was in, it dawned on me-surely not for the first time- that everything I do, say and act on as a follower of Jesus is all tied up in me being His disciple. I know that I know this. I have known this for quite some time to one degree or another. But it hit me much differently this time in this set of circumstances.

Not only am I being "discipled" by Jesus through others in the Body of Christ, He is using me to disciple others, and it's something each one of us is called to do. [By the way, just a side note, you will not find the word "disciple" used as a verb in the Bible, at least not in the New American Standard Bible translation that I use. And when I typed "disciple" in the verb forms above, I got the red underlinings telling me I'd done it wrong. Interesting...] Anyway, the part of this that I've gotten all along is that I am a disciple of Jesus, often learning through others in the Body of Christ how to live a more Christ-like life. But where my epiphany came for me is that I am also discipling others, specifically as it relates to my role as Ministry Director of Abba's Delight. discipling those men in our Overcomers support group and those who attend our Family and Friends support group by providing them a plan and a forum for how to find the Lord's grace and provision to deal with the impact that homosexuality has had on their lives. They are equipped with various tools for their overcoming process, but more importantly, what my course has been and continues to be for each one is to point them towards Jesus; to nudge them to be in touch with Him as their source for love, life, grace, mercy, peace, etc; to help them see Him clearer when they seem to be fighting to stay

focused on Him. So for me, the revelation was that what I have been doing these several years in ministry is actually <u>discipleship</u>.

Many of us, including myself, have been scared to use the "D" word for quite some time, for fear it would cause to resurface in the saints unpleasant memories of past spiritual experiences. But the fact is Jesus never called it "mentoring," "accountability," or the "buddy system." He told us to make disciples. And not just to get them into the family of God, but to help them to stay in the family of God, so that they do not become like the seeds that are choked out and die, but instead grow through obedience to Him.

We should consider it a blessing and a calling to be offered a role in Father's plan to bring His kingdom to the earth, and for His will be to done on earth as it is in heaven. Each person's journey toward becoming and living as a disciple of Jesus will be different from others', but as long as we are poised toward Him, with our eyes fixed on Him, we'll be able to receive from and learn from one another as His disciples, and we'll be able to pass along to those coming behind us what He is teaching us. Not just so we can be swell folks in the end, but so that we can be useful in His kingdom as faithful sons and daughters.
