Biblical Sexuality in the Black Church

On Saturday, September 19, 2015, I took part in the first Symposium on Biblical Sexuality in the Black Church. Since the beginning of this year, I had been meeting with a number of African American Baptist pastors to plan and coordinate this inaugural event. I was invited to participate by the pastor to whom the Lord imparted the vision for this gathering. He and I have been friends for about a dozen years, having met in a recovery program. It was a blessing and a privilege to work together with these men of God over the months to present this conference here in Louisville, KY where most of the planners and participants minister. Getting to know them, and they being introduced to me and the work I do through Abba's Delight, were valuable for us all, and I am hopeful about the prospect of ministering in some of their churches in the weeks and months ahead.

Topics for the symposium included: A Sexual Revolution in the Black Church; A Biblical Response to Homosexuality and the LGBTQ Community; Sexual Abstinence Before Marriage; Pornography in the Church; A Biblical View of Co-habitation; and A Biblical Response to Sexual Abuse & Exploitation. There were also a couple of panel discussions throughout the day for which attendees, numbering about 400, could submit questions electronically during the event.

I had invited Aqueena "Queen" Smith from Chicago, who spoke regarding the Biblical Response to Homosexuality and the LGBTQ Community. Queen runs a ministry in a church in Chicago and I've known her since our days in Exodus. She is now also affiliated with the Hope for Wholeness Network, <u>www.hopeforwholeness.org</u>, as is Abba's Delight. During my sharing at the symposium, I presented my testimony and touched on some of the work that Abba's Delight does in ministering to born-again believers who wish to live beyond their same-gender sexual issues, families and friends who have gay-identified loved ones, and churches that wish to deal with homosexuality in a redemptive way. Also during this segment, I interviewed one of my African American participants in our Overcomers Group, who was able to share a good bit of his story of the Lord leading him out of homosexual sin. The Lord's timing of this event was perfect! Many churches have become lax in dealing redemptively and effectively with sexual sin in their midst. Sometimes, the pastors themselves have secret sins they are afraid to disclose for fear of being fired or removed from ministry, while others do not address sexual issues due to pressure from congregants or fear of tithes and offerings declining if messages aren't positive and uplifting so that everyone can always leave happy. So, pastors often opt for a God loves us message over a God disapproves of our behaviors message. In the area of homosexual sin, there are more and more churches all the time sacrificing Biblical integrity to choose the way of inclusion so no one gets offended. Additionally, in the last few years there has been released the Queen James Version of the Bible. I have heard one pastor here in Louisville touting its authenticity as being equally valid as any of the traditionally accepted translations of God's Word. Christianpost.com reports that its publishers have stated that it "accurately translates certain verses pertaining to homosexuality, which have been misunderstood by religious conservatives." In other words, hundreds of years of Biblical scholars are suddenly wrong about homosexuality being a sin, according to the Queen James publishers.

Coincidently, or many not so, on the same day as the Symposium, the Louisville Pride Festival took place with an estimated 12,000 attending. A large section of Bardstown Rd in Louisville was closed to traffic to allow for the event to celebrate Louisville's pride in its diversity. Also, on the following day after the Symposium, the TV show Iyanla: Fix My Life presented on the Oprah Network (OWN), introduced the world to two African American pastors here in Louisville who have now come out as gay in the interviews she did with them when she traveled here.

One of the things I appreciated most about the Symposium, was a portion of the welcome statement in the program which read, "...a symposium designed to equip African American pastors and churches with a biblical basis for understanding human sexuality. This is the inaugural event of a brand new organization the Holy Spirit led me to initiate which is called African Americans for Biblical Authority (AABA). Members of the AABA have a convictional commitment to the Bible as the inspired, inerrant, and infallible Word of God. As such, we believe it is our final authority in all matters related to faith and life, inclusive of human sexuality."

Our churches must get back to recognizing and living by the authority of the Scriptures, and building our lives around God's revealed design and plan, not trying to create God in our own image based on our emotions and attractions hoping He'll approve.
