Many of the former Exodus affiliates joined the Hope for Wholeness network, which continues to thrive since its inception. Earlier this month, McKrae submitted his resignation, which was accepted by the Hope for Wholeness Board of Directors.

Abba's Delight ministry is a Hope for Wholeness ministry referral, and I currently serve on its national Board of Directors as Vice-Chairman.

McKrae has become a personal friend over the years, and I am excited to see what God does in his life as he lays down ministry for a season to embark on other life adventures. I wish him the fullness of God's will and destiny for his life in the kingdom.

Below is McKrae's resignation letter.

Dear friends,

Many of you know that this type of ministry can be very demanding and extremely stressful on those of us involved, as well as our families. I was very open at this year's Hope for Wholeness

conference about strong considerations toward resigning. Prior to the conference, I took a bit of a sabbatical, working a part-time job and spending time away from the office, in an effort to relieve some of the stress and recharge. However, after careful consideration and prayer, I have determined that it is time for me to turn the reigns of the ministry over to another person. I do not know what God has for this new season of my life, but I believe, and my wife Julie agrees, that it is time for a change.

I want you all to know what a joy it has been to serve each and every one of you, either as a client in one of our groups or counseling, as an attendee of one of our many conferences, as co-laborer in ministry, or as a very valued prayer and financial partner. I have been deeply blessed by all of our interactions and fellowship. You will always be family to me, and I hope you know how much you will always mean to me and my family.

Ministry is at the core of who I am. Even though I am resigning as the President of Hope for Wholeness, I will always be involved in helping and encouraging people. First though, I need some rest from the public life of ministry. While I will never turn those away that seek me out, I would encourage you to seek the leadership of HFW for counseling and support. Hope for Wholeness has been my life's work and I pray that you will continue to support and be involved in the efforts of the HFW family. It will always be a ministry that is close to my heart.

I ask for your prayers during this season where I am seeking God's will and way for me and my family and know that we will also be praying for you. God bless you each in your individual ministries and on your journey with God.
