THIS MONTH'S MEDITATION SCRIPTURE: Jesus answered and said to Nicodemus, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born again (from above), he cannot see (experience) the kingdom of God." John 3:3

February 27, 1970

Forty-nine years ago today, the Holy Spirit revealed the person of Jesus to me for the first time. I had heard of Jesus growing up, learned about Him in church, but never knew about a personal relationship with Him. That night, I began mine with the help of some high school friends. As I began to grow in my new life, I would hear others talk about life verses the Lord had given them from the Bible. He gave me a life Psalm. It's on the ministry website both in video form and in written form entitled "Beyond Surviving." I am, however, going to share my life Psalm with you. It is Psalm 30. It will probably mean a lot more to you if you watch or read the testimony first.

Let it sink in to your spirit. Let it minister to you. If you are struggling with any kind of victory in your life, from this psalm of David you will be reminded of God's protection over from your enemies. Be blessed as you chew on these words. (Jer. 15:16)

Psalm 30 New American Standard Bible (NASB)

Thanksgiving for Deliverance from Death.

A Psalm; a Song at the Dedication of the House. A Psalm of David.

I will extol You, O Lord, for You have lifted me up, and have not let my enemies rejoice over me. O Lord my God, I cried to You for help, and You healed me. O Lord, You have brought up my soul from Sheol; You have kept me alive, that I would not go down to the pit. Sing praise to the Lord, you His godly ones, and give thanks to His holy name. For His anger is but for a moment, His favor is for a lifetime; weeping may last for the night, but a shout of joy comes in the morning. Now as for me, I said in my prosperity, "I will never be moved." O Lord, by Your favor You have made my mountain to stand strong; You hid Your face, I was dismayed. To You, O Lord, I called, and to the Lord I made supplication: "What profit is there in my blood, if I go

down to the pit? Will the dust praise You? Will it declare Your faithfulness? Hear, O Lord, and be gracious to me; O Lord, be my helper." You have turned for me my mourning into dancing;

You have loosed my sackcloth and girded me with gladness, that my soul may sing praise to You and not be silent. O Lord my God, I will give thanks to You forever.
