

Board of Hope for Wholeness Votes to Cease Operations

On Tuesday, June 16, 2020, the following announcement was posted on all of the Hope for Wholeness FaceBook pages. Your prayers are most appreciated for the 700+ saints who have been ministered to by this organization over the last 7 years, and for me as I work to establish a new network. Thank you.

"A letter from the board of Hope for Wholeness:

It has been a tumultuous several years for us. We lost the founding director, searched for two years for his replacement, hired a new director and then lost that director as well. After much prayer and discussion, we have made the difficult decision to dissolve the organization. This was not an easy decision. But we do believe it is the right decision.

We do believe there is a place for a ministry like Hope for Wholeness. But we believe it needs to be a new, fresh start. We have been carefully stewarding the finances that many have given us. We will be forwarding all of the remaining finances to Abba's Delight to be used to start up a new network of ministries. I wrote the following to our FaceBook groups: "A number of news stories have broken about the dissolving of Hope for Wholeness since the HFW board statement was released this past week on 6/16. Some of the news media and many in the gay community are reveling in their perceived victory that another 'conversion therapy' giant has folded. The Scriptures tell us that without God, man is incapable of seeing the truth. So, we shouldn't be surprised or outraged that this is their take on our transition. As sons and daughters of our heavenly Father, we are placed in the world but are charged to not be of the world, not to belong to the world, not be subject to the world's ideologies and perceptions. We have a higher perspective, a higher calling, as we are seated with Christ in heavenly places. The hope for our future lies in Jesus who is our sole Hope, even the Hope of the world. In this transition period, as the Lord makes clear His vision, direction, and purpose in the coming months, I encourage you all to give yourselves to praise and worship and prayer, sowing into what lies ahead in His economy. Love from Louisville."
