## **Identity is Everything!** Pulled from the Archives in August 2018

When we received Jesus into our hearts in our born-again experience, we became sons of God, as told to us by John 1:12 when he wrote, "But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right(power) to become children of God." At that moment, God rescued us out of the world of darkness and brought us into the light of His kingdom. The apostle Peter reemphasizes this truth in his first letter in 9:2, stating, "But you are A CHOSEN RACE, A royal PRIESTHOOD, A HOLY NATION, A PEOPLE FOR God's OWN POSSESSION, so that you may proclaim the excellencies of Him who has called you out of darkness into His marvelous light..." And the Spirit also bears witness of our new relationship as sons of God.

When I became a son of the Father, I also became a brother to Jesus, and a co-heir with Him to the Kingdom of God, which means I am no longer a slave to sin and darkness. I have a new identity which is in Christ Jesus, my Savior, King and Lord. My true citizenship is in His kingdom, not in my earthly country of origin, as Paul tells us in Philippians 3:20, "For our citizenship is in heaven, from which also we eagerly wait for a Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ..." And then in Ephesians 1:11, he again writes, "...also we have obtained an inheritance, having been predestined according to His purpose who works all things after the counsel of His will..."

And it is a component of the will of God that our identity be in Christ Jesus, in no one else or nothing else. We are to allow the power of the Spirit to conform us to the image of Jesus, and to no other image. Our lives are not to be conformed to this world, rather to be transformed by the renewing of our minds that we may prove the good, acceptable and perfect things of God's will.

Because my identity is in Christ, and my destiny is tied up in His plan and purpose for my life here on earth as well as in heaven, I choose to leave behind any identity that binds me to

the sins of my life. I am defined not by my sinful nature to which I die daily, but by my sonship in the kingdom of God. I desire no other identity than that, the one my Father has given me.
