The Mercy of the Lord

We often hear a lot about God's grace, but not many seem to talk about His mercy. I don't know about you, but I find myself constantly in need of His mercy. As I have grown older in the Lord, I have become more and more aware of my sinful self. I used to think that the older I'd get, the less I'd have to deal with my sin nature, therefore the less I'd have need of His mercy. Maybe it's just me, but that hasn't been the case at all.

In the Old Testament, it appears that mercy is most often translated 'lovingkindness'. In the New Testament, most often it is 'compassion.' Either way, to me it is a much-prized benefit for those who are Jesus-followers.

In the Bible, Lamentations 3:22,23 tell us His mercies are new every morning. 1 Kings 8:23 tells us that His mercy toward us is connected to His covenant with those who follow Him with all of their hearts. Psalm 100:5 says His mercy is everlasting. Micah 6:8 reads, "He has told you, O man, what is good; and what does the Lord require of you but to do justice, love mercy and to walk humbly with your God?" Ephesians 2:4 says God is rich in mercy, and 1 Peter 1:3 tells us God the Father's great mercy has caused us to be born again through the resurrection of Jesus to obtain an imperishable inheritance. And these are just a few of a multitude of references in Scripture about how wonderful God's mercy is toward us.

I am thankful that the Lord's lovingkindness and compassion are toward me, but I am most grateful that those mercies are everlasting, as I'm pretty sure I'll need them right into eternity.

Responses From You

From a brother in Brazil: Yes, brother. We do not serve God "in exchange" for complete freedom from feelings or temptations, or for healing, or for prosperity or for anything for that matter. We serve Him because we are His, we have been blood bought, we belong to Him twice - for having been created by Him and later redeemed by Him. It is only in glory that our redemption will be complete. In the meantime, though, we do have the freedom to live without sin - not perfectly, but we do grow in holiness - and we also notice that the strength and frequency of SSA temptations do get less. I believe some ministries in the past have erred leading people to believe there could be a complete change in orientation. Who cares if that change does not come? It's being faithful to Him that matters. We are no longer slaves to our passions. The world will never understand that, but it remains true, nonetheless. I praise God for faithful ministries like yours. May the Lord continue to bless you with fruit!
