I'm remembering a Christian band from the '70s called Hope of Glory. One of their songs was "Jesus Never Broke My Heart." It speaks to me of His love, and of His faithfulness towards me. "I've had my share of troubles all of my born days. I've seen the hearts that have easy lives. I've known the world and its evil ways. But Jesus never broke my heart. I believe and know that this dry spell will eventually end for me. I am not fretting that. I continue to press in to my Father, my Savior, and my Comforter as I move forward in Him. I am secure in His love for me and in His ongoing plan and purpose. No better place to be!
