End of Year Donations

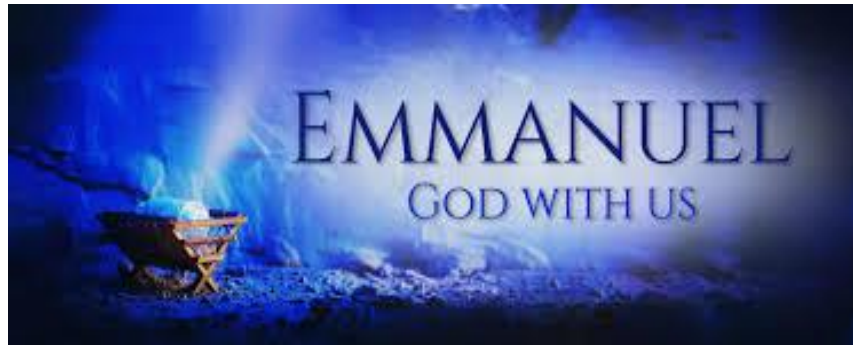
