There Has Been Born for You a Savior, Who is Christ the Lord

In my 20 years of ministry, scores of men have told me their stories of the wounds they still carry, having grown up with fathers who most likely loved them but didn't know how to show it in ways their sons were able to receive it, or recognize it as love. We all carry father wounds. I know I have, and without a doubt I created some wounds in my own three sons. Many of us have experienced a measure of healing from these wounds, but I believe a great many more are still hurt, damaged and scarred because reconciliation with their dads has escaped them, or maybe was unsuccessful.

Recently, I was contacted by one such man who heard of the ministry I do. He shared with me that he knew his dad loved him, but that he also was criticized by his dad constantly, even telling his son one time that he wished the son had never been born. Another time dad said to him, "You make me sick, and I've never been more disappointed in anyone." His dad believed he could make his son better by pointing out his flaws whenever they were displayed. His dad was a pastor, so he was a pastor's kid (PK). His dad was well known in the town and well-loved by everyone, but the man seen about town was not the same man who the family experienced at home. His son loved and hated and feared his dad. There was no disagreeing or sharing different opinions in their home. Mom was present, and she was loving and caring toward the son, but she was largely silent regarding Dad's behaviors.

It was at Christmas time when the son was a teenager that his dad told him he wished he'd never been born. Dad was so angry he announced to the family he was canceling Christmas. This wasn't the only year he made that declaration. Though dad passed away many years ago, the son continues to be afflicted, brokenhearted, and held captive by the cruel things told to him by his dad for which he has not received healing, and therefore still a prisoner in need of being set free from the sinful behaviors he engages to numb the pain. Sadly, stories

like his are very common in our ministry genre. It is for this son, now a grown man, and billions of us just like him, for whom Jesus came as Christ the Savior.

As we near our celebrations with our family and friends of Jesus' coming, let's be mindful that we have the ability to choose love and compassion; we can choose to allow love to cover a multitude of sins; we can choose to overlook difficult personalities; we can choose to serve rather than be served; we can choose love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. Because against such things there is no law.
