THIS MONTH'S MEDITATION SCRIPTURE: It is better not to make a promise than to make one and not keep it. Ecc 5:5

Let Your Yes Be Yes And Your No Be No

Our God keeps His promises. He honors His word and He fulfills what He has spoken. He doesn't go back on His commitments, always doing what He says He will do.

We are created in His image. As our Father's sons and daughters, we have committed to living our lives in such a way that we are becoming more perfectly conformed to the image of Jesus. Jesus left His heavenly home to take on flesh as we are. He is our Father's first-born Son and provided an earthly example for us to follow.

That means that we should be men and women who keep our promises, honor our word, and fulfill commitments we make, doing what we say we will do. We must let our yes be yes, and our no be no. We cannot go back on our word when it becomes inconvenient for us to keep a promise. In Judges 11, though the promise Jephthah made to the Lord was careless, illadvised, and politically motivated, the story reveals the heartache he endured by keeping his promise to the Lord, which resulted in the death of his daughter; yet he stayed true to his word. And in Acts 5, when Ananias and Sapphira held back a portion of the sale proceeds of a piece of property, God struck them down. These examples are not meant to dissuade us from making promises, rather they teach us of the responsibility we have to be mindful of what we are about when we do, and the vital importance of honoring them. When we fail to honor commitments we have already made, we show those we committed to that our word is not reliable, that we are not trustworthy. And that is not a faithful representation of God's life in us.

If God is leading us into a commitment or a promise, He should be the only one to lead us out of it through fulfillment. Meanwhile, as we are in the process of fulfilling it, we must be faithful to it. It is a sobering process, honoring our words. But as we remain faithful to it, our Father will honor us.
