THIS MONTH'S MEDITATION SCRIPTURE: *Let the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be acceptable in Your sight, O Lord, my rock and my Redeemer. Ps 19:14*

The Words of Our Mouth

Proverbs 18:21 tells us, "Death and life are in the power of the tongue, and those who love it will eat its fruit." Our words matter! They have the ability to edify and encourage, or they can crush and destroy. Words spoken out of our mouth have the ability to control our whole body as reflected in James 3:2, "For we all stumble in many ways. If anyone does not stumble in what he says, he is a perfect man, able to bridle the whole body as well."

Our words reveal what is in our hearts. Jesus tells us in Luke 6:45, "The good man out of the good treasure of his heart brings forth what is good; and the evil man out of the evil treasure brings forth what is evil; for out of the abundance of his heart his mouth speaks."

Proverbs 12:18 contrasts destruction vs healing, "There is one who speaks rashly like the thrusts of a sword, but the tongue of the wise brings healing;" and the contrast of the wise and the foolish is presented in Proverbs 15:2, "The tongue of the wise commends knowledge, but the mouth of fools spouts folly."

Our tongues can be used for blessing and cursing, so much that the majority of the third chapter of James' epistle is devoted to addressing how we use our tongues. Verses 8-10 describe it this way, "But no one can tame the tongue; it is a restless evil and full of deadly poison. With it we bless our Lord and Father; and with it we curse men, who have been made in the likeness of God; from the same mouth come both blessing and cursing. My brethren, these things ought not to be this way."

But rather, let us strive to use our words to honor, build up, esteem, and respect those we engage day to day; as Paul instructed in Colossians 4:6, "Let your speech always be with grace, seasoned, as it were, with salt, so that you may know how you should respond to each person."
