Free Will: God's Gift, Mankind's Friend or Foe

When God created man, free will was included in his make-up. Over history, free will has proven it can be a friend of man, and at other times it has proven it can be his foe. But each and every time it all depends on the human's choices. Even for born-again, Bible-believing children of God our choices will make all the difference in our outcomes.

Have you ever had to make a decision that had more than one option, and you weren't sure which one was the Lord's will? Or which one would take you in a righteous direction? Or which one would blow up in your face? Most of us always want to be right. We don't want to be making mistakes in our lives. Some mistakes are not sins, but some are, as they say, whoppers. I cannot tell you how many times in my life I've begged God just to send somebody, anybody, to tell me what I'm supposed to do.

Then there are the times when we're being triggered or tempted. For those of us who because of the fall have inherited or developed an addictive nature, we still have the free will to make the choices that will honor God and keep us out of sin, yet often still feel helpless to overcome our sin nature in the moment. Though in our right thinking, our minds know the righteous choice, that's not the one that wins out all the time. I can remember times of resisting and resisting, only to give up in the end and jump into the sin, just so the battle would stop for the moment. Obviously, that is what is called in addiction circles stinkin' thinkin'. But that is where many end up. Then comes the shame of our choice, piling up on us.

When guys whom I've discipled over the years come struggling with repetitive and besetting sins, I've sometimes encouraged them to try to remember how bad they feel about themselves in that moment when they've fallen so that when the enemy comes again with his ammunition and lies, they will exercise their free will in a God-honoring way and send the devil away.

Guy Hammond, a former gay man and founder of Strength in Weakness ministry, spoke recently to a group of church leaders which I attended. He made a very simple yet impactful statement that has the potential to stop each of us in our tracks when a decision to sin or not is in our path. He said, "You have the right to make your own choices, but you do not have the right to choose your own consequences." God has laws written, and words spoken, in place already that determine our outcomes when we unwisely choose sin over holiness. The verses above remind us of this truth. May we always remember Whose we are in the day of trouble!
